



## Add-In Permissions

When you install the Huna Add-In, you will see some permissions being requested:

- Maintain access to data you have given it access to
- View your basic profile
- Read your calendars

### Permissions requested

This app would like to:

- ✓ Maintain access to data you have given it access to
- ✓ View your basic profile
- ✓ Read your calendars

Let's walk through each one of these, but before we do, make an important note: **Huna cannot access your files, OneDrive, Calendar, or other private data unless you give it explicit permission to do so.** By default, the only information the add-in will use is what you are typing in (e.g. your document or email) and what libraries you have subscribed to on <https://huna.expert>.

As for the individual permissions, let's start with "Maintain access to data you have given it access to". According to [Microsoft's Documentation](#) on this topic, *all* consent screens will contain this permission. The purpose of this permission is to maintain access to your OAuth 2.0 authorized sources *only if you have already provided access* (such as explicitly linking your OneDrive to Huna). You can revoke access at any time by logging into your [profile settings](#).

Next is "View your basic profile". This permission allows the app to see your basic profile information: name, picture, user name ([reference](#)).

Finally, the "Read your calendars" permission allows Huna access to your Outlook calendar *if and only if you choose to connect it*. As a feature, Huna makes your calendar searchable if you choose to authorize it to do so in your account settings. Again, **Huna cannot access your calendar** unless you explicitly connect it in your [account settings](#).
